BYSTANDER INTERVENTION: PUTTING

A STOP TO SEXUAL ASSAULT

This program carefully explains the basics and principles of bystander intervention, a strategy that has proven effective in the reduction of sexual assault. The video begins by dramatizing the infamous Kitty Genovese case where many observers did not step in to prevent an assault in Kew Gardens, Queens, New York. This behavior came to be called the Bystander Effect. Bystander intervention, explained in the video, is a powerful tool that arms bystanders with techniques to counter the bystander effect by getting witnesses to stop violent acts or sexual assaults by using their brains. Using dramatizations of sexual assault situations viewers are taught three ways to disrupt a sexual assault: intervene directly, create a distraction, or call for help from others nearby. Real teens who have successfully intervened in attempted sexual assaults describe how they followed the principles and foiled an attempted sexual assault.

EXPLORING OUR NATION: EQUAL PROTECTION UNDER THE LAW

CHAPTER 1. THE NINTH & TENTH **AMENDMENT**

Students will learn that the Ninth Amendment in the Bill of Rights states that the rights of citizens are not limited to those rights spelled out in the constitution. The program discusses that the Tenth

Amendment was intended to maintain a balance of power between the federal and state governments. Students will come to realize that a system of government that divides power between federal and state governments is called federalism.

2. THE THIRTEENTH, CHAPTER **FOURTEENTH** AND **FIFTEENTH AMENDMENT**

The information provided in this video help students to understand the impact of the thirteenth, fourteenth and fifteenth amendments to the constitution. The thirteenth abolished slavery. fourteenth provided "equal protection" of the laws while the Fifteenth Amendment guaranteed all men the right to vote. The program also examines important cases that challenged those laws and the Supreme Court's rulings on those cases through the years.

CHAPTER 3. EQUAL PROTECTION AND EXTENDING RIGHTS

This program examines how the Supreme Court refused to recognize the intention of the Fourteenth Amendment and the equal protection clause. Students will learn about the concept of "separate but equal" and about the Supreme Court decisions that ushered in the modern civil rights movement leading to the Equal Pay Act, the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Voting Rights Act, the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act and others.

the constitution and the laws passed by congress are the "supreme law of the land." The program explores how, over the years, the court changed its way of thinking. Viewers will learn that the Supreme Court adopted a policy known as "selective incorporation" or the "incorporation doctrine." Students will learn that through "selective learn that through incorporation" the Court decides over time and on a case by case basis, which provisions of the Bill of Rights will extend to the states.

CHAPTER THE **FOURTH AMENDMENT**

Viewers will learn that the Fourth Amendment begins with the assumption that citizens have the right to live free from unreasonable interference from the government. Students will come to understand that the amendment provides parameters of how, when and why law enforcement can conduct a search of a person or property. The program examines the meaning of "probable cause" and "reasonable suspicion." Students will also discover that the Fourth Amendment rights, as interpreted by the Supreme Court, don't necessarily apply to students in school.

CHAPTER 2. THE FIFTH AMENDMENT

This video examines the Fifth Amendment of the United States Constitution and the rights of citizens accused of crimes. Students will learn about Miranda rights and self-incrimination. Viewers will also come to understand what it means to "take the fifth" as well as other rights protected by the Fifth Amendment including the right to a grand jury, protection against double jeopardy and "due process of law."

CHAPTER 3. THE SIXTH AMENDMENT In this program students will learn that the sixth amendment to the constitution guarantees the rights of people accused of a crime. Viewers will learn about those rights and how they protect citizens. Students will also learn how the Supreme Court has interpreted those rights through years and how the court's interpretations impact people today.

Students will learn about the seventh amendment and that it guarantees a trial by jury in federal civil cases. The eighth amendment cites that bail money allows a person accused of a crime to be released from jail until the time of their trial.

FEDERAL ENVIRONMENT AGENCY, THE: AIMING HIGH WITH SUSTAINABLE DESIGN (MATTHIAS SAUERBRUCH & LOUISA HUTTON)



Matthias Sauerbruch and Louisa Hutton set up Sauerbruch Hutton in 1989, now based in Berlin. Their best known buildings include the GSW Headquarters in Berlin, for which they were nominated for the Stirling Prize in 2000.

In this talk they focus on the Federal Environment Agency in Dessau. completed in 2005. With its mix of low-tech materials and high-tech production processes, the building was designed to showcase the best in sustainable architecture.

Hutton and Sauerbruch describe the development of the building's curvilinear plan along the route of an old railway line, and their use of colour, a constant in their work; how any sustainable building is only as efficient as the people who inhabit it; and how a concern for environmental efficiency has been a running thread through their work, from their Photonics Centre Berlin in 1998, through Museum Brandhorst, 2008, Munich Re, 2014, and the soon to be completed M9 Museum in Venice-Metre.

The loyalty people have for the party of liberation operates at a

psychological level. But in recent years, the ANC's popularity is at an all time low, not least amongst people who were once its most loyal supporters. The nation's sense of unease is only made worse by high profile corruption cases surrounding President Jacob Zuma and friends, and compounded patronage and the ANC's unwillingness to cut him loose. 

REAL LIFE TEENS: BLOWING SMOKE, VAPING TEENS & SMOKING

ADDICTION

E-cigarettes have been called the next generation cigarette and vaping the way newest for teens to start smoking. Studies state 1 in 4 high school students have already tried e-cigarettes. Teens who vape are more likely to start smoking than teens who don't and nonsmoking teens who start vaping are 3 times as likely to start smoking cigarettes. So what makes Vaping so dangerous? Most teens assume vaping is harmless, however it is not. E-cigs contain mostly "nicotine", which can wreak havoc with the cardiovascular system and lead to hypertension and heart attacks. Nicotine is an addicting substance and can work as a "gateway" drug to smoking regular cigarettes. In its concentrated, potent, liquid form, nicotine is blended with a variety of flavorings, colorings, assorted chemicals and toxins to create a vapor. It's this nicotine that can cause an addiction and fuel a teens' transition from vaping to smoking. Vaping might be hard to notice since there is no cigarette smoke or smell of it. Many vaping devices are designed to look like pens; compact, shiny and easy to disguise. Vaping can cause as much short-term inflammation in the lungs as regular cigarettes and the nicotine-free vapor may cause even more. Also fueling the trend is the accessibility of oil concentrates. A vape pen creates an inhalable vapor with a small inner coil that slowly heats, creating a vapor that is inhaled. Water-soluble synthetics are easily converted into liquid concentrate that can go into the device cartridges and be vaped just like nicotine and other legal substances. It makes it nearly impossible to tell what's inside someone's vape. It could be nicotine, marijuana concentrate, or fruit-flavored or nicotine-free "e-liquid." Worst of all, it could be a deadly concoction of chemicals, known as synthetic drugs.

The biggest danger may lie in the use of vaping devices. After a teen is used to some nicotine in the form of an e-cigarette, they may ultimately transition to traditional cigarettes to get nicotine more easily and Vaping devices are also auickly. compatible with marijuana, cocaine, THC liquids and other drugs, making substance abuse easier, less publicly recognizable and easier for a teen to hide. The devices create a further danger for teen users who may not be completely aware of what's inside the electronic cigarette. Student discussion includes: What is vaping? What is the vapor made from and how does it work? ls vaping dangerous? e-cigarettes contain toxins? Are e-cigarettes dangerous? Do e-cigarettes contain nicotine? Is nicotine harmful? Is nicotine addictive? What are the short and long term side effects? Are teens who vape or use e-cigarettes more likely to start smoking?



Rehab or treatment for addiction begins with the desire to stop using drugs or alcohol and choose a clean and sober life. For many teens, this may seem like an impossible task especially when their life seems to have lost all meaning. YOU CAN KEEP YOURSELF **SAFE: TOUCHING SAFETY** & STRANGER SAFETY

Through age-appropriate vianettes students will learn the difference between a safe and an unsafe touch. Students will come to understand that any touch whether it's a high-five, a hand shake, a kick, a fist bump, a punch or a kiss can be labeled safe or unsafe depending on the situation and whether or not someone agrees to the touch. The video reinforces the message that only YOU can decide if it's a safe touch or an unsafe touch and that YOU set the boundaries. Viewers will also come to know about "private parts" of the body and that nobody should ever touch your "private parts" with a few exceptions.

Students will learn what they can do when they feel uncomfortable with a touch and determine it is an unsafe touch. Students will understand the importance of saying STOP and repeating it over and over again until the perpetrator complies. They will come to realize that they're in charge of their body and that only they can decide if it's a safe or unsafe touch.

4 out of 5 sexual assaults are committed by someone known to the victim. Students will learn to never keep a secret, especially when it comes to unsafe touches. Many students who are sexually assaulted have feelings of anger or guilt that present through dramatic changes in behavior and attitude. In the video, students will learn the importance of not keeping secrets and the need to get help by telling the secret to a trusted adult.

Today, trafficking children for sexual exploitation is the fastest growing criminal enterprise in the world. Through coercion and deception teens and young women are forced into the sex trade. In this program, students will come to understand the tactics and methods "strangers" use to manipulate and recruit their victims. Students will learn the warning signs and learn what to do to avoid potentially dangerous situations.



Graham Stirk is a senior partner at Rogers Stirk Harbour + Partners, having first joined the practice in 1983 when it was titled the Richard Rogers Partnership. 



"No one is going to want to spend \$5 on an orange," Jesus' daughter says. Faced with stifling water restrictions, caused in part by environmental concerns over sea life, farmers like Jesus have few options.

Compounding the problem is the reality that without water, their trees will destroy the soil. So farmers uproot their trees and wait. But re-growing citrus trees takes years. Or they can gamble, hoping that this season will be the last one without water.




