COUNTDOWN: REFLECTIONS ON A LIFE IN DANCE - RUDY PEREZ

Directed by Rachel Perez Bitan

For more than 40 years, choreographer and dancer Rudy Perez has invigorated the American dance scene. In the 1960s he was hailed as a postmodern pioneer at the groundbreaking Judson Dance Theater in New York. He garnered critical acclaim for his solos and for the choreography he created for his own dance ensembles, which often included unusual humorous elements.

This film follows the fascinating rehearsal of one of Perez's signature dances, Countdown with the talented dancer Victor Quijada in Los Angeles. Throughout the rehearsal process, Rudy's life and career are revealed through evocative home movies, archival videos of his body of work, and rare footage of New York in the 50s and 60s. After enduring an impoverished childhood, Perez left his Puerto Rican family at 17 and began his dance training with the legendary New Dance Group, studying with Martha Graham, Merce Cunningham, and Mary Anthony, among others. Included are interviews with dance critics, dancers, and collaborators who discuss Perez's impact on the East and West Coast dance scenes.

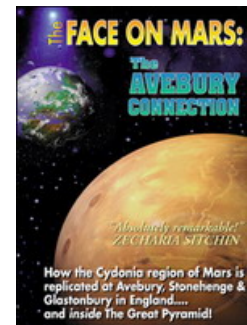

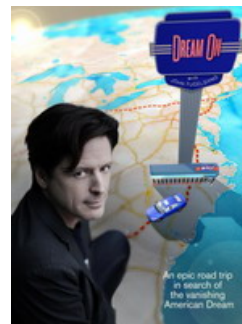

LAW NOT WAR: BEN FERENCZ'S FIGHT FOR JUSTICE

Law Not War is a moving portrait of the last surviving Chief Prosecutor of the Nuremberg Trials, 95-year-old Benjamin Ferencz. The film offers both a look back into history as well as an examination of current issues of war, justice and the International Criminal Court (ICC). From historic Court Room 600 in Nuremberg, Benjamin Ferencz relives his memories of the famous trials through intimate interviews, which are interwoven with historic film footage and statements from other international leaders in the field.

Ferencz's life is defined by his remarkable journey from a poor, immigrant family in Hell's Kitchen, New York through Harvard Law School, to become Chief Prosecutor at the Nuremberg trials at the age of 27. At an age when most people's careers have not even begun, Ferencz was prosecuting the Einsatzgruppen, the group of Nazi soldiers who were known as death squads, and who were responsible for mass killings that took place during the Holocaust.

After the Nuremberg Trials, Ferencz became a tireless fighter for the ideals that they represented. He devoted his life to the principle that war crimes should be prosecuted, and he worked relentlessly for the ICC to actualize that, despite the fact that the political climate during the Cold War was not favourable to his position.

Ferencz still travels the world today, 70 years after the Nuremberg Trials, seeking both peace and justice for those who commit war crimes. 70 years later, his struggle is as relevant now as it was in 1945. As Ferencz himself says, "We have to turn to law instead of war. Or else we

will destroy the whole world."

A Place Without People: Tanzania tells the story of the eviction of the indigenous people from their lands in Tanzania to clear space for the creation of the world's most famous nature reserves. In Tanzania, one of the world's poorest nations, the government, tourist industry, and conservation organizations have advanced the idea that Africans are intruders into what was once a pristine Garden of Eden.

The film describes how prior to World War II, the land of the Maasai was seized by British colonialists to set aside for their own sport—hunting. Although there was no evidence that local people threatened wildlife, it was decreed that "no men, not even native ones, should live inside its borders."

The film explores how Western perceptions about nature have evolved through time and how these perceptions radically altered this East African landscape and the culture of its natives. From the famous wildlife reserves of the Serengeti and the Ngorongoro to the remote mountains of Mahale, the documentary gives voice to the indigenous people who continue to be antagonized and excluded as the tourist industry rapidly depletes the area's water and other natural resources.

In 1960, NBC aired what some consider to be the first "reality television" show in American broadcast history. Hosted by Jane Wyatt of Father Knows Best fame, and billing itself as a "new kind of visual reporting," it was called Story of a Family, and it purported to document the day-to-day lives of the 10-member Robertson family of Amarillo, Texas. While the show has since faded from public memory, media scholars and television historians now recognize its significance as a precursor to the unscripted television programming that dominates American television today. In TV Family, filmmaker Ethan Thompson draws on the recollections of several of the children featured in the show to offer a fascinating behind-the-scenes account of the making of Story of a Family. Weaving personal anecdotes from the Robertsons with commentary from TV historians and cultural critics, Thompson tells the story of how the show's producers carefully choreographed the way they wanted the family to appear to the American public -- all in the name of authenticity. The result is an eye-opening look at one of the television industry's earliest attempts to shape the "reality" of family life in commercially viable ways. WHEN THE SHOOTING STOPS

Directed by Lisa Davis Larry

The scars left by violence never go away. "When the Shooting Stops" portrays the journeys of four families after violent gun deaths or injuries change their lives forever. Each surviving family member takes a unique path of healing; some toward acceptance, some forgiveness, some actively promoting peaceful conflict resolution, and some having little resolution at all. In a variety of ways, many of them positive, the families give meaning to their own lives and to the life that was lost to violence.

The four families include: filmmaker Lisa Davis Larry's family involving her grandfather, Charles Caplin, a store owner killed during an armed robbery; Colonel (Ret.) and Mrs. Wilbert Bryant, the parents of Lisa Bryant, a cum laude Princeton University graduate and Army officer, who was shot and killed by an Army sergeant at Fort Bragg, North Carolina; the Hawkins family who lost two adult sons, Joe Hawkins and Gerald Roberts, in separate shootings; and the family of Gilbert Salinas, who survived a permanently debilitating shooting at a party, and his wife, Cindy who is herself a survivor of a drive-by shooting at age 12 while retrieving her mail.

Although violent news stories of shooting victims and grieving families can be seen every day, the personal stories of the families' recoveries are rarely made known. "When the Shooting Stops" puts faces, personalities, hopes and dreams to the survivors of gun violence, providing insights and actions that help the healing process while revealing the true cost of violence.
